Stunts:

I've Read About That! (Scholar): You've read hundreds—if not thousands—of books on a wide variety of topics. You can spend a fate point to use Scholar in place of any other skill for one roll or exchange, provided you can justify having read about the action you're attempting.

Best Foot Forward (Rapport): Twice per session, you may upgrade a boost you receive with Rapport into a full situation aspect with a free invocation.

Eavesdropper (Investigate) On a successful Investigate roll to create an advantage by eavesdropping on a conversation, you can discover or create one additional aspect (though this doesn't give you an extra free invocation).
